Summer Camp Suggested Items List**

Hello from Mallard Manor! Below is a suggested list of items that your child may need to make their camp experience more enjoyable. We kindly ask that parents refrain from dropping kids off early and promptly pick up their child on the final day of camp.

Check-In is from 5-6 p.m. on Sunday and

Camp Commencement is from 12-12:30 p.m. on Wednesday

(Pick-up time for kids staying over and taking optional Hunter's Ed. Certification for specified camps will be at 5 p.m. on Wednesday...**not all camps include the class.** Please read over our website.)

1. Sleeping bag or top sheet with blanket & Pillow (required)
2. Sunscreen
3. Bug Spray (We suggest Repel Sportsmen MAX 40% or like product but nothing higher than 40% Deet) & ThermoCELL
4. Camera
5. Clothing for 4 days (Shorts, Jeans, T-shirts, and Older Swimsuit (two-piece swimsuits must be accompanied by a t-shirt)
6. Hat
7. Polarized Sunglasses (for Bowfishing & Anglers camps)
8. Boots (We strongly recommend that each camper bring a pair of knee-high rubber boots.)
9. Flashlight
10. Toiletries (Towels, bath cloths, shampoo, etc.)
11. Bible (Notebook & Pen)
12. Medicine (Each camper should bring their own medicines that they may need during their stay at camp. All medicines will be locked in our Pro Shop and administered according to parent's instructions. Please have medicines clearly labeled with dosing administration on each bottle.)
13. Archery Equipment (We do have archery equipment available for all activities. However, we recommend that campers bring their own if available. We encourage youth to build archery skills with their own equipment. Please only bring arrows with field points. Bowfishing equipment is also allowed and encouraged for our Bowfishing Camps. **No firearms or knives permitted.**)
14. Fishing Equipment (Campers are required to bring their own fishing poles and lures if they plan on fishing. Our lake is stocked with hybrid bass and bream.)
15. Game Calls (Camper may want to bring their own duck or turkey calls to practice with during Game Calling Seminars.)
16. Snacks (We will provide snacks during free time. Campers are welcome to bring their own favorite snacks and store them in the kitchen area. Please be prepared to share and keep in mind that campers are not allowed to have food or drink in their room.)
17. Release Forms (We must have a signed release form from parent or legal guardian before child may attend camp. This can be downloaded off of the Mallard Manor Ministries page of our website at: www.mallardmanor.com. Also, if your child will be attending a Hunter's Education Course, they must be at least 10 years of age and the state of MS requires their social security number and valid mailing address in order to receive certification.)
18. If your youth is attending our Predator Camp, please also pack lightweight camouflage.

19. Valid MS hunting/fishing license (ONLY required for youth ages 16 and older. If your youth is a non-resident of MS OR has not had a hunters education course....please call our office for assistance.)

Mallard Manor Ministries Important Information

Reservation Policy: In order for your child's name to be placed on a particular date for any of our programs, we must have a 50% deposit due within 7 days and release form.

For example: If we receive a call or email requesting a particular date, we will notify you ASAP whether or not it is available. If it is available, we will pencil your child's name in for the event for 7 days while we wait to receive your deposit check via mail. After the 7 days are up, your child's name will NOT be placed on the attendee list until a deposit is received in the office. If the date is already full by the time the deposit is received, then if any dates are still available, we will give you the next available date option. The final balance will be due 2 weeks prior to arrival. Our goal with our ministry programs is to maximize our impact on kids and we cannot do this when we turn away youth due to unknown cancellations. We believe that this will best serve our youth as we seek to keep offering this wonderful experience in the future.

Cancellation Policy: Mallard Manor Ministries requires parents to give a 2 week notice to cancel their event date. If a parent cancels less than 2 weeks prior to the event, all funds will be forfeited and the parent will have the option to find a replacement to go in their child's place instead. Otherwise, funds will be used by Mallard Manor to scholarship another child.

Rooming Policy: We often receive the request from parents for their child to room with a particular child attending our programs. We do strive to honor these requests, however, in some instances these requests may not be granted due to number of attendees that week, timeliness of reservation, and behavior. We believe that part of the program experience is for youth to branch out of their normal routine and form new friendships.

NOTE:

If your child will be attending a specific camp session that includes Hunter's Education Certification; the state of MS requires them to be at least 10 years of age, possess their social security number and valid mailing address in order to receive certification. (NOT ALL CAMPS INCLUDE HUNTER'S EDUCATION CERTIFICATION)

Summer Camp Check-In is from 5-6 p.m. on Sunday (meal at 6:30 p.m.)

Camp Commencement is from 12-12:30 p.m. on Wednesday

(Pick-up time for kids attending a camp that includes the optional Hunter's Ed. Certification given on the final day vs. specific camps taking the course during the week will be at 5 p.m. on Wednesday.)
